



Super 7 Welsh Ladies Club Cup – Back to Bowls

Total Number of Players: 7

1 x Triples plus 1 Substitute = 4

1 x Pairs plus 1 Substitute = 3

Dress Code: Tops - White or Coloured. Bottoms - White, Grey or Black trousers, cut offs or shorts. Bowling Shoes - Any colour.

Format of Games – Knockout Competition:

- Each discipline plays 2 sets of 7 ends
- First set toss for jack. Whichever team lost the toss in first set, then they start the second set
- One trial end
- In the event of a draw at 1 set each they will then play
- a 1 end shoot out – winner wins the game (toss for jack)
- Each substitute **must play** in both sets and must stay within that discipline throughout the match. Each discipline can choose when to play their substitute, but substitutes must play a minimum of 3 ends.

Who can enter:

- Any club affiliated to the Welsh Women's Bowling Association in 2021
- Clubs may enter as many teams as they wish
- If your club has not got enough players, please feel free to team up with another club/s within your county
- Competitions will be run either within counties or in a zone with a final decision on this being made dependent on entries, whilst ensuring clubs have a sufficient number of games
- The club draw will be published and updated
- Clubs drawn out first will play at home – this again is dependent on entries and whether games are played within counties or zones (if you have merged with another club/s, we will take the club listed first on the entry form as the home club)
- The final 8 clubs will then go into a draw to compete during Welsh Finals fortnight in September

Other:

- Entry fee £21 per club (equates to normal £3 entry fee per player)
- Each player must be affiliated to the WWBA
